## **New Business:**

- 1. **Approval of Minutes:** The minutes of the February 16 regular meeting and May 8 special meeting were approved as distributed.
- 2. **Treasurer's Report:** The financial reports for February and March were approved as distributed. BBO games are going well and earning a positive bottom line. Steps are being taken to reduce expenses such as liability insurance and costs of storing supplies and equipment.

- 5. **Website Update:** Our Webmaster has updated the site to include the list of trophy winners. Lamya suggested we put the results of the Sunday games on the website as well. Kathy will work with Lamya on this.
- 6. **The Longest Day:** The event will occur this year on the weekend of June 21, the date of a Unit game. Discussion included whether to add an additional \$1 to the game fee and how to solicit additional donations. It was decided to charge \$6 that day, and a subcommittee consisting of board members Lamya, Jane, Sam and Kathy will work with Beth and Sarah Granby to develop a plan for advertising, the donations/auction process, etc.
- 7. **Elections:** Holding a regular election process this year would be impossible because of the pandemic, so Lamya asked whether the current directors are willing to continue for another year. All agreed to do so. Stuart will draft a message for distribution to the Unit's members explaining this decision.
